

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Many products used in the home, garden, garage, and hobby shop contain hazardous chemicals that can potentially harm the user or the environment.

Items marked as follows should be considered hazardous:

- "caution"
- "causes severe burns on contact"
- "danger"
- "do not use near heat or flame"
- "eve and skin irritant"
- "flammable"
- "harmful or fatal if swallowed"
- "hazardous"
- "keep out of reach of children"
- "poison"
- "use in a well-ventilated area"
- "vapor harmful"

Use safety precautions when using, storing, or disposing of any hazardous products. When discarded, they become household hazardous waste requiring proper disposal.

- Keep products in their original, labeled containers.
- Share leftover products with friends, neighbors, and others who can properly use the product.

By appointment only. El Paso & Teller County residents ONLY (Proof of residency is required) **See page 2 for further details.**

If you have paint totaling more than 50 gallons and/or a large load of hazardous waste items, manager approval is *required*. Call 719-520-7879 or email **KathyAndrew@elpasoco.com** to schedule the appointment and for further questions.

CHEMICALS

Paint, Stains, Solvents, etc.

Latex, oil-based, aerosol, and hobby paints; stains, strippers, solvents, thinners, lacquers, varnishes, etc.

<u>Lawn & Garden:</u> Lawn and houseplant fertilizers, herbicides, insecticides, rodent poisons, wood preservatives, etc.

NOTE: Waste must be in labeled, non-leaking containers that can be left onsite.

<u>Household:</u> Aerosols, ammonia, batteries (<u>household only. No corrosion/leaking. Must come in clear resealable bag no larger than 1 gal</u>), bleach, cooking/lamp oils, cleaners (carpet, drain, oven, toilet), fire extinguishers, fireworks, fluorescent tubes, furniture polish/wax, mace, mercury, nail polish & remover, perfume, pepper spray, propane tanks (1-lb & 20-lb), salt spray, smoke alarms, etc.


<u>Automotive:</u> (No tires – see page 29) Antifreeze*, Auto batteries, brake/transmission fluid*, cleaners (bug/tar, chrome, engine, vinyl, fuels, wax, etc.), fuels, motor oil*, oil filters. *Each marked item is limited to 10 gal. per household per month. Containers must be no larger than 5 gal and must be left onsite.

ELECTRONICS

TVs (*CRTs* must be 20" or smaller; flat screens 40" or smaller), central processing units [CPUs], computer monitors, keyboards and mice, printers, fax machines, laptops, notebooks, ultra-books, net books, electronic tablets, DVD players, VCRs, radios, stereos, video game consoles, video display devices with viewing screens greater than four inches diagonally.

MEDICAL SHARPS Must be in a certified red medical sharps container **no more than 2.2 quarts large** (can be purchased from a pharmacy). No more than two containers per household per month.

PORCELAIN (sinks, toilets, ceramic tiles, & granite/marble countertops). <u>Must remove</u> toilet seat, flushing mechanism, faucets, adhesives, etc. Items must be unloaded into **4-foot dumpster without staff assistance.** (The County is partnering with Colorado Springs Utilities to recycle crushed porcelain for use in local roads.)





To ensure safety of HHWF staff and to protect the personal property of customers, the staff will not enter your vehicle. All individuals bringing household hazardous waste will be required to remove each item from their vehicle and place them onto a cart provided by staff. Please ensure that someone in the vehicle is able to accomplish this.

Items Accepted in the Recycling Bins:

All items must be clean prior to drop off (free of food, liquid, dirt, etc.)

- Cardboard: Old Corrugated Cardboard (OCC) only
- Glass: Food & Beverage only (no lids/corks)
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin Cans (must discard paper)
- Newspaper
- Office Paper: No shiny paper (such as wrapping paper), no paper smaller than 8 ½ x 11"

If the item is not on this list, it will NOT be accepted in the bins.




